**Welcome and Introductions, Approval of Agenda and CAC Minutes.**

Dennis Flanagan, CAC member, started the meeting with a round of introductions. *All approved the previous meetings minutes.*

**Ongoing MPO Efforts**

Nick Kroncke briefed the group on efforts regarding the Coffee with a Planner events, the adoption of the MTP 2045 and Hellbender Regional Trail updates. Ongoing studies such as Hendersonville Road was mentioned. Nick provided an overview of the nearly 100 results received from the MTP 2045 survey.

**Public Involvement Policy**

Nick provided an overview of the PIP, what it entails and how it is used to engage the public. Changes proposed involved updating with FAST Act language, providing alternative meeting methods (virtual), online participation guidelines, defining TIP amendments versus modifications. He asked for the groups feedback if it worked and how the 45 day public comment period would work. The group was supportive of the changes.

**Project Updates/Q&A** - MPO staff gave a brief update on the VMT numbers from the region and project delays as received from NCDOT in September. Discussion took place around how this could affect projects in the region. Other members discussed how long it may take for NCDOT to know the extent of the project delays.
