
Transit Changes

MTP Requirements

- Required for MPOs
- Must be Updated Every Five Years (every four years in areas not meeting air quality standards)
- Projects 25 Years Into the Future
 - Population and Employment Projections
 - Travel Demand Model Projections (where congestion is expected to increase)
 - Financial Projections
 - Project List Reflecting Regional Priorities (funded/TIP projects are required to be in the MTP)





Population & Employment Projections




- 189,000 new residents by 2045

Travel Demand Model


- Reflects projected congestion issues in 2045

MTP Requirements


- MTPs are required to have a financial planning aspect that projects how much funding will be available for transportation improvements over 25 years and how those funds may be used

How the STI Works





MTP 2045- Projected Funding in the FBRMPO










Ideal Process

- **Issue #2: projects are frequently submitted to SPOT that aren’t in the CTP or MTP -> better long-term planning needed to get ahead of these issues**


Long-Term Project Selection

Step 1: Supplement the CTP with Needs Identified by Local Government and NCDOT representatives




Long-Term Project Selection
