

## Item 4A

### P 7.0 Submittals

### What is P 7.0 and the Prioritization Process?

The Prioritization Process (aka SPOT) is the process that determines the majority of capital improvement projects funded through NCDOT and NCDOT's allotment of federal funds. The process is governed by the Strategic Transportation Investments (STI) Law of 2012 that provides the framework for a more data-driven and transparent process that also utilizes local input from NCDOT Divisions, MPOs, and RPOs. In relation to other aspects of transportation planning, the prioritization process serves as the bridge to determine what long-range needs are funded in the TIP/STIP for implementation.



P 7.0 refers to the seventh iteration of the prioritization process in North Carolina and will be the process that determines what new projects are funded in the 2026-2035 TIP/STIP.

## Item 4B:

### Locally Administered Projects Program (LAPP) Updates

### What is the Locally Administered Projects Program (LAPP)?

LAPP is a term that is used to differentiate projects selected by the MPO utilizing direct allotments of federal transportation funds vs. projects that go through NCDOT and other funding streams. LAPP projects are funded with Surface Transportation Block Grant- Direct Allotment (STBGDA), Transportation Alternatives Program- Direct Allotment (TAPDA), and Carbon Reduction Program- Direct Allotment (CRPDA.) There are eligibilities about who is able to receive these funds and what these funds are allowed to be used on. In general, the FBRMPO has largely utilized these funds for bicycle and pedestrian improvement project around the region.

### **Changes Requested**

- Defund BL-0079 (the Texas Road Pedestrian Bridge) (Town of Montreat)
  - NCDOT updated cost estimates for the project and the Town determined that the costs exceed their initial estimates and plan to consider a locally-funded option
  - $\circ$  This project had \$153,000 in federal funds allocated for use in FY 2024
- Increase funding for HL-0003 (the Haywood Road Bicycle and Pedestrian Improvement Project) (NCDOT Division 13)
  - The project manager with NCDOT requested an additional \$80,000 for engineering

### **Other Changes**

- BL-0078 has requested funding be moved from Construction to Engineering to begin design
- EB-5824 (Hominy Creek Greenway, Buncombe County) has been delayed for additional time for design
- EB-5822 (North RAD Greenway, City of Asheville) has been delayed for additional time for design
- EB-5547A & EB-5547B (Riverwalk Bike/Ped Improvements, Town of Black Mountain) has been delayed for additional time for design

To note: The MPO policy on project delays advises a reconsideration of the projects after two delays. EB-5824, EB-5547A, and EB-5547B have now been delayed two times since their last reconsideration.

### Other Items to Note

• MPO staff will request annual updates for LAPP projects

# Item 4C:

### Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) Update

After updating the MPO's Planning Area, the MPO is required to update its Memorandum of Understanding. Several updates are required, either to update language to current federal law or to change committee and Board designations for members who may or may not apply any longer. 



Hours of Delay For the Five-County (Buncombe, Haywood, Henderson, Madison, and Transylvania) Area with 2023 Projected Through End of Year







### Top-10 Bottleneck in the Five-County Area – August, 2023




