





DID YOU KNOW THAT BETWEEN 2019 AND 2023,

there has been 40,234 reported crashes occurred on local and state roadways. Of those crashes, more than 500 people were killed or seriously injured.

Interstates, US routes, and NC routes represent about 7% of the roadway network in Buncombe County, but more than 60% of fatal and serious crashes occurred on these roads
