Quick Introduction

What is P8/the Prioritization Process?

The Prioritization Process (also known as P8 or "SPOT") is a "data-driven and transparent" process in North Carolina that determines what transportation improvement projects are selected for funding. The process is structured by the Strategic Highway Investments Act of 2012 and involves NCDOT, Metropolitan Planning Organizations (MPOs), and Rural Planning Organizations (RPOs), along with local government partners, public transit providers, airports, and others.

What are "Project Submittals"?

Every NCDOT Division, MPO, and RPO is given a set number of projects they may submit- by transportation mode- to the prioritization process for consideration. Once these organizations submit their projects, the projects are given a quantitative score based on data points, and (potentially) considered for local input points from NCDOT Divisions, MPOs, and RPOs, and the highest scoring projects are programmed based on available funding.
