
International Winter Bike to Work Day

1-40 Update

Interstate 40 in the Pigeon River Gorge reopened on March 1, following extensive repairs from Hurricane Helene. Governor Josh Stein and NCDOT Secretary Joey Hopkins announced the reopening, highlighting the efforts to reconnect North Carolina and Tennessee and boost the local economy. The reopening features one lané in each direction between Exits 20 and 15, and from Exit 7 to the state line, with a 40-mph speed limit and restrictions on oversized loads. Permanent reconstruction efforts are underway. NCDOT remains committed to restoring full functionality to this vital transportation corridor.



The State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) is a federally required document that reflects planned transportation investments over a 10-year period. The STIP describes each planned project, a schedule for implementation, funding sources, estimated costs, and is required to be in-line with MPO Transportation Improvement Programs (TIP). NCDOT released the draft 2026-2034 STIP and due to rising costs, multiple committed projects from the FBRMPO region were decommitted. Projects will have the opportunity to recompete for funding during the next prioritization cycle, slated to start later this year. For a full list of decommitted projects, click **here**.
